The conference is divided into the sections *i-Science* and *i-Praxis*. These two formats offer different perspectives on the topic: *i-Science* represents a theoretical approach to different science-related issues, whereas *i-Praxis* examines questions from an economic perspective.

*i-Praxis* motivates technology developers, users, researchers and students to exchange ideas on the basis of lectures dealing with questions and solutions from business practice.

We invite you to submit your proposal for a presentation at *i-Praxis*. Your proposal should include at least one of the following aspects:

- Presentation as a technological leader and/or innovator, through for example the presentation of praxis-proven solutions.
- Presentation of current tasks for developers and possible approaches to solutions.
- Demonstration of currently unsolved problems and future challenges from the perspective of practice.
